This guide has been published to assist students in preparing for transfer to Webster University from East Central College in the areas of Creative Writing, English,

college level coursework of at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale is preferred; however, each applicant is given individual consideration. If you have circumstances which might affect your admission this may be discussed confidentially with a member of the admissions staff. The University operates on rolling admission, and application files are reviewed by an admissions counselor as soon as all requested credentials have been received.

Each transfer applicant must submit:

- A completed Application for Admission
- An official transcript from East Central College and an official transcript from all other postsecondary institutions previously attended mailed to:

IMPORTANT TRANSFER NOTES

- x Webster has a minimum residency requirement that 30 of the student's last 36 credits must be taken at Webster University. All students must have a minimum of 12 credit hours to graduate.
- x A minimum of 21 credit hours within the major must be completed at Webster University.
- x Each student must complete at least 12 credit hours of courses for the major at the 3000 or 4000 level.
- x Students must earn a grade of C or better in any course they wish to apply toward the major or general education/GCP.
- x Webster University provides full transfer of coursework successfully completed as part of an associate degree awarded by a regionally accredited institution. While students with associate degrees typically transfer 60
