TRANSFER GUIDELINES

- x Students who have completed the South Carolina Criminal Justice Academy Basic Law Enforcement must submit an official Academy graduation certificate with academy graduation date and an official South Carolina Criminal Justice Academy transcript
- x Students matriculating at Webster University may be eligible to receive credit hours of transfer credit at the lower division, baccalaureate level.
- x No credit will transfer which duplicates credit already earned through coursework at Webster or at any other postsecondary institution.
 - o If academy credit overlaps content of credit earned at another college or university, the student must receive credit for the overlapping content only once.
